WHEN it comes to American country music classics, it doesn't get any bigger than Johnny Cash, Willie Nelson and Kenny Rogers, and direct from the US are three performers replicating the sounds of that country's favourite musical sons.

The Kings of Country show will weave the music of these three people in one massive performance.

Kenny Rogers tribute singer Marty Edwards said the show was a must for lovers of country music.

"If there's one thing Australia shares with the USA, it's being a frontier country - and frontier countries love nothing more than a good old-fashioned country song," he said.

"The three guys are legends in the business and have endured over the years longer than almost any other artists."

The show will feature individual tribute performances from Phillip Bauer as Johnny Cash, Marion Deaton as Willie Nelson and Marty Edwards as Kenny Rogers.

Billed as one of the closest experiences music fans would get to seeing the real performers, the show will also see the three singers performing some classic songs together on stage.

"There's a couple of surprises where we share the stage, but most of all it's just going to be a massive show," he said.

"The one thing these guys really have in common is that they're all storytellers, and they all reflect the lives of the common, working man," Edwards said.

"For me, each and every song comes from the heart and you really have to not only sing, but tell a story as well."
